

## EDWARD CORRIGAN EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP Guidelines

1. Name: Edward Corrigan Educational Scholarship

**2. Established:** SEA transferred scholarship to FSPS in 2008

3.

**4. Amount:** The amount of the scholarship will vary each year according to

interest earned on the corpus of the fund. The award amount should not exceed the available interest earned unless the difference would be

supplemented from other sources.

**5. Purpose:** To assist students in continuing their education.

A. There will be one fund with two equal scholarships awarded annually, the Edward Corrigan Educational Scholarship and the Edward Corrigan Memorial Scholarship (separate Guideline).

- B. Application must rank in the upper one-fourth of the graduating class, demonstrate good citizenship, leadership, dependability initiative, perseverance and seriousness of purpose.
- C. Applicant must have demonstrated financial need and limited resources to continue with their education.
- 6. Procedure:

5. Criteria:

- A. Scholarships will be awarded to a graduating senior and will rotate annually between the five high schools. No one school shall receive more than one award in any given year.
- B. The High School scholarship selection committee will make their recipient recommendation.
- C. After receiving proof of enrollment, the Foundation shall send a check payable to that institution.
- D. The scholarship will not be renewable. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based on the same protocol.
