

SARAH LEIGH DAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP Guidelines

1. Name: Sarah Leigh Day Memorial Scholarship

2. Established: In Memory of Sarah Leigh Day. Sarah was a member of the 1993

Glendale High School Class. She was a cheerleader and active in other School organizations. Sarah was vivacious, full of life and a good friend.

She was tragically killed in an automobile accident in 1991. SEA

scholarship transferred to FFSPS in 2008.

3. Amount: The amount of the scholarship will vary each year according to

interest earned on the corpus of the fund. The award amount should not exceed the available interest earned unless the difference would be

supplemented from other sources.

4. Purpose: To assist students in continuing their education at a college,

university, technical, trade or vocational school.

5. Criteria: A. Applicant must be a graduating student from Glendale High

School in the Springfield R-12 Public School system.

B. Application must rank in the upper one-fourth of the graduating class, demonstrate good citizenship, leadership, dependability,

initiative, perseverance and seriousness of purpose.

C. Applicant must have demonstrated financial need and limited

resources to continue with their education.

6. Procedure: A. Scholarship will be awarded annually to a graduating senior

from Glendale High School.

B. The Glendale High scholarship selection committee will make

their recipient recommendation.

C. After receiving proof of enrollment, the Foundation shall send

a check payable to that institution.

D. The scholarship will not be renewable. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based

on the same protocol.
