1.	Name:	Doris Thompson Memorial Scholarship
2.	Established:	February 2001
3.	Amount:	The amount of the scholarship will be a minimum of \$500.00 annually. If interest earned is less than the scholarship amount, the family will provide the difference.
4.	Purpose:	To acknowledge the sincere efforts of a graduating mother and to offer assistance as she strives to make a life for herself and her family.
5.	Criteria:	A. Applicant must be a graduating senior from Bailey Alternative High School.
		B. Applicant must be deemed by the faculty as making a sincere effort to create a life for herself and her family. The applicant should also exhibit a strong work ethic.
		C. Applicant is not required to show financial need nor is there a minimum GPA required.
		D. Applicant is not required to pursue additional education.
6.	Procedure:	A. Scholarship will be awarded annually to one or more graduating mothers at Bailey Alternative High School based upon two letters of recommendation for each applicant; one from a Bailey teacher, principal, or counselor, and one letter from an adult outside of Bailey.
		B. The selection committee should include at least two members of the Bailey Alternative staff.
		C. Upon notification from the selection committee, the Foundation for Springfield Public Schools shall send a check payable to the recipient.

- D. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based on the same protocol.
