

## GLENDALE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP Guidelines

1. Name: Glendale High School Students Memorial Scholarship

**2. Established:** This scholarship was established to honor the memory of faculty and

students who are deceased. SEA scholarship transferred to FFSPS in 2008.

**3. Amount:** The amount of the scholarship will vary each year according to

interest earned on the corpus of the fund. The award amount should not exceed the available interest earned unless the difference would be supplemented from

other sources.

**4. Purpose:** To assist students in continuing their education.

**5. Criteria:** A. This scholarship will be awarded annually to a senior of a Glendale High School.

B. Scholarship must be used toward payment of higher education.

- C. Application must rank in the upper one-fourth of the graduating class, demonstrate good citizenship, leadership, dependability, initiative, perseverance and seriousness of purpose.
- D. Applicant must have demonstrated financial need and limited resources to continue with their education.
- E. The student must not be receiving full scholarship moneys from other sources as known by the selection date by the scholarship committee.
- F. Student must write a paragraph stating how they feel they meet the requirements.
- **6. Procedure:** A. Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior.
  - B. The high school scholarship selection committee will make their recipient recommendation.
  - C. After receiving proof of enrollment, the Foundation shall send a check payable to that institution.
  - D. The scholarship will not be renewable. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based on the same protocol.
