

DR. H. LEE HOOVER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Guidelines

1. Name: Dr. Lee Hoover Memorial Scholarship

2. Established: Dr. Hoover was a community member of the SEA Scholarship

Corporation for many years. SEA transferred this scholarship to the

Foundation For Springfield Public Schools in 2008.

3. Amount: The amount of the scholarship will vary each year according to

interest earned on the corpus of the fund. The award amount should not exceed the available interest earned unless the difference would be

supplemented from other sources.

4. Purpose: To assist a Springfield High School student. There are no restrictions.

5. Criteria: A. This scholarship shall rotate between the five Springfield Public

High Schools on an annual basis.

B. Application must rank in the upper one-fourth of the graduating class, demonstrate good citizenship, leadership, dependability,

initiative, perseverance and seriousness of purpose.

C. Applicant must have demonstrated financial need and limited

resources to continue with their education.

6. Procedure: A. Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior.

B. The High School scholarship selection committee will make their recipient recommendation. If there are no applicants who meet the

restrictions, this scholarship will not be awarded.

C. After receiving proof of enrollment, the Foundation shall send

a check payable to that institution.

D. The scholarship will not be renewable.
