The Colonel's Scholarship for Central High School

Guidelines

1. Name: The Colonel's Scholarship

2. Established: March 2002

3. Purpose: To acknowledge the sincere efforts and patriotic interests of a

graduating Central High School senior and offer financial

assistance to further that student's education.

4. Criteria: a. Applicant must be a graduating senior from Central High

School

b. Applicant must be deemed by the faculty as making a sincere effort to continue his/her education with an interest in government service. (i.e., military, FBI, CIA, diplomat or

Peace Corps.)

c. Applicant is not required to show financial need nor is there a

minimum GPA required.

d. Applicant may be pursuing education at a college, university,

technical or trade school.

4. Amount: The Foundation will contact the family, who will determine the

amount awarded for that year.

5. Procedure: a. Scholarship will be awarded annually to a graduating senior at Central High School based upon application and letters

of recommendation from one teacher and one principal or

counselor.

b. The selection committee should include at least one Central faculty member, one community volunteer (preferably a

current or retired government employee), and a representative

of the Foundation for Springfield Public Schools.

c. Upon notification from the selection committee, the Foundation for Springfield Public Schools shall send a check

payable to the educational institution of choice.

- d. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based on the same protocol.
- e. The scholarship is not renewable.
