Name of Scholarship: **WILLIAM BRANDON BOWMAN CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL FOREIGN LANGUAGES SCHOLARSHIP**

Description: Bill Bowman was a 1956 graduate of Central High School. He taught French for many years in Springfield Public Schools. He later became Curriculum Supervisor for Foreign Languages.

Criteria:

1. This scholarship is to be awarded annually to an outstanding graduating senior at **Central High School** who has been active in the Foreign Language Department and has the intention of furthering foreign language study at the college/university level.
2. Financial need is not a consideration.
3. The Foreign Language Scholarship Committee will determine the recipient of the scholarship. The Committee will be made up of the Central High School foreign language teachers.
4. The scholarship winner will be announced at Night of Honors.

Applicants will be ranked in each of these five equally weighted areas:

1. Number of levels (years/semesters as appropriate) of Foreign Language Study
2. Overall GPA
3. Foreign Language GPA
4. The need for Foreign Language in the student's career choice with those planning to teach a Foreign Language being ranked first
5. The Central Scholarship Committee's evaluation of the student.
