



CHARLES R. HALL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Guidelines

1. **Name:** Charles R. Hall Memorial Scholarship
2. **Established:** This scholarship was established in memory of Charles R. Hall. Mr. Hall was involved with the music program in the Springfield Public Schools for many years- as a teacher at Central High School and as Coordinator of Music for the district. He was very involved with the Springfield Symphony and the Springfield Youth Symphony. Transferred from SEA to the FFSPS in 2008.
3. **Amount:** The amount of the scholarship will vary each year according to interest earned on the corpus of the fund. The award amount should not exceed the available interest earned unless the difference would be supplemented from other sources.
4. **Purpose:** To assist students in continuing their education.
5. **Criteria:**
 - A. This scholarship will be awarded annually to a senior of a Springfield High School who will attend an accredited college or university. Scholarship will rotate between the 5 high schools on an annual basis. **Preference will be given to a graduate who has been active in the music activities of the school.**
 - B. Application must rank in the upper one-fourth of the graduating class, demonstrate good citizenship, leadership, dependability, initiative, perseverance and seriousness of purpose.
 - C. Applicant must have demonstrated financial need and limited resources to continue with their education.
6. **Procedure:**
 - A. Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior.
 - B. The high school scholarship selection committee will make their recipient recommendation.
 - C. After receiving proof of enrollment, the Foundation shall send a check payable to that institution.
 - D. The scholarship will not be renewable. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based on the same protocol.
