



SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 1930 SCHOLARSHIP *Guidelines*

- 1. Name:** Senior High School Class of 1930 Scholarship
- 2. Established:** This scholarship was established by and is in honor of the Springfield Senior High School Class of 1930. Mrs. Winifred Graves, who taught Mathematics at Central High School, was very instrumental in the establishment of this scholarship. SEA scholarship transferred to the FFSPS in 2008.
- 3. Amount:** The amount of the scholarship will vary each year according to interest earned on the corpus of the fund. The award amount should not exceed the available interest earned unless the difference would be supplemented from other sources.
- 4. Purpose:** To assist a Central High School senior in pursuing their education.
- 5. Criteria:**
 - A. This scholarship will be awarded annually to a graduating senior of Central High School who plans to continue his/her post high school education.
 - B. Application must rank in the upper one-fourth of the graduating class, demonstrate good citizenship, leadership, dependability, initiative, perseverance and seriousness of purpose.
 - C. Applicant must have demonstrated financial need and limited resources to continue with their education.
- 6. Procedure:**
 - A. Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior of Central High School.
 - B. The High School scholarship selection committee will make their recipient recommendation.
 - C. After receiving proof of enrollment, the Foundation shall send a check payable to that institution.
 - D. The scholarship will not be renewable. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based on the same protocol.
