



SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 1933 SCHOLARSHIP *Guidelines*

1. **Name:** Senior High School Class of 1933 Scholarship
2. **Established:** The Springfield Senior High Class of 1933 established this scholarship. SEA transferred to FFSPS in 2008.
3. **Amount:** The amount of the scholarship will vary each year according to interest earned on the corpus of the fund. The award amount should not exceed the available interest earned unless the difference would be supplemented from other sources.
4. **Purpose:** To assist students in continuing their education.
5. **Criteria:**
 - A. Applicant must be a graduating student from Central High School.
**This scholarship shall alternate years for Boy-Girl: In even numbered years the scholarship shall be awarded to a female.
In odd numbered years the scholarship shall be awarded to a male.**
 - B. Application must rank in the upper one-fourth of the graduating class, demonstrate good citizenship, leadership, dependability, initiative, perseverance and seriousness of purpose.
 - C. Applicant must have demonstrated financial need and limited resources to continue with their education.
6. **Procedure:**
 - A. Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from Central High School.
 - B. The Central High scholarship selection committee will make their recipient recommendation.
 - C. After receiving proof of enrollment, the Foundation shall send a check payable to that institution.
 - D. The scholarship will not be renewable. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based on the same protocol.
