



Devon Roberson Memorial Viking Singer Scholarship

Guidelines

Name of Scholarship: Devon Roberson Memorial Viking Singer Scholarship

Established: February 2015

Description: This scholarship will be for a Parkview High School Senior enrolled in the choir department. It will go to a student who shows passion for music through their studies, extracurricular activities, and daily life.

Amount: \$1,000

Criteria: To qualify for this scholarship a student must have:

- 2.75 GPA
- Acceptance to a college or university
- Enrolled in Choir at Parkview High School
- A passion for music of all kinds

Procedure:

- Write an essay (at least a page, no more than two pages) answering the questions:
 - “What song has been most impactful on your senior year and why?”
 - Choral/Radio/Old/New/Any song!
 - “What role does music play in your daily life?”
 - “What role does music play in your future?”
- Don’t get too caught up in professionalism. Show us you LOVE it!

- On a separate sheet of paper, provide lyrics (if applicable) and a CD of the song chosen in question 1. (Put Essay, Lyrics, and CD in a large envelope so we don't lose anything!)
- Funds will be dispersed to the selected candidate's college/university in their name.
- Winning candidate will be selected by the Parkview High School Choral Director, Rhett Roberson, and Brendan Roberson.
- Funds will be paid to the Foundation for Springfield Public Schools in one lump sum of \$5,000 to be dispersed at \$1,000/year for 5 years. The scholarship amount will be revised at the end of the 5 year period.
