



DAVID EUGENE DOSS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Guidelines

- 1. Name:** David Eugene Doss Memorial Scholarship
- 2. Established:** This scholarship was established in memory of David E. Doss, a member of the Parkview High School graduating class of 1969. David died in an auto accident in January 1972. SEA transferred to the FFSPS in 2008.
- 3. Amount:** The amount of the scholarship will vary each year according to interest earned on the corpus of the fund. The award amount should not exceed the available interest earned unless the difference would be supplemented from other sources.
- 4. Purpose:** To assist students in continuing their education at a college, university, technical, trade or vocational school.
- 5. Criteria:**
 - A. This scholarship will be awarded annually to a senior of Parkview High School who will attend an accredited college or university. Preference will be given to a graduate who plans to major in instrumental music.
 - B. Application must rank in the upper one-fourth of the graduating class, demonstrate good citizenship, leadership, dependability, initiative, perseverance and seriousness of purpose.
 - C. Applicant must have demonstrated financial need and limited resources to continue with their education.
- 6. Procedure:**
 - A. Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior of Parkview. Preference given to a student who plans to major in instrumental music.
 - B. The high school scholarship selection committee will make their recipient recommendation.
 - C. After receiving proof of enrollment, the Foundation shall send a check payable to that institution.
 - D. The scholarship will not be renewable. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based on the same protocol.
