



Arthur P. Elbert Science Education Scholarship Fund

Guidelines

- 1. Name:** Arthur P. Elbert Science Education Scholarship Fund
- 2. Established:** 2013
- 3. Amount:** Each year an award of \$1000.00
- 4. Purpose:** To assist and motivate students who aspire to become teachers in the field of science education.
- 5. Criteria:**
 - A. Applicant must be a graduating student from Kickapoo High School and plans to continue their education in the field of science education .
 - B. Applicant must be interested in pursuing a degree in science education from an accredited college or university.
 - C. Applicant must have maintained at least a 2.5 GPS while taking college prep courses during high school.
- 6. Procedure:**
 - A. Scholarship will be awarded annually to a graduating senior from a Kickapoo High School.
 - B. Student must complete the Arthur Paul Elbert Science Education Scholarship application and have at least one letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or counselor.
 - C. The Kickapoo High School scholarship selection committee composed of both Kickapoo science faculty and counselors will choose the recipient. This committee will verify that the recommended recipient meets all established criteria and make their recipient recommendation to the Foundation for Springfield Public Schools.

- D. After receiving proof of enrollment from the student, the Foundation shall send a check payable to that institution.

- E. The scholarship will not be renewable. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based on the same protocol.
