Dr. Sally Johnson Memorial Scholarship
for Springfield Public Schools
Guidelines

- 1. Name:** Dr. Sally Johnson Memorial Scholarship
- 2. Established:** October 1995
- 3. Amount:** The amount of the scholarship will awarded at \$1000 annually. The amount shall be supplemented by family members as needed.
- 4. Purpose:** To assist and motivate outstanding students to continue their education at a college or university and to encourage them to pursue academic studies in family and consumer sciences.
- 5. Criteria:**
 - A. Applicant must be a graduating senior in the Springfield R-12 Public School System who intends to enter an accredited college or university on a full-time basis.
 - B. Applicant must be in the top 15% of his/her graduating class.
 - C. Applicant must have financial need relative to educational expenses.
 - D. Applicant must have a strong interest in pursuing studies in family and consumer sciences with preference for, but not limited to, child development and/or early childhood education.
 - E. Applicant must have completed at least two courses in the Family and Consumer Sciences curriculum.
- 6. Procedure:**
 - A. Scholarship will be awarded annually and rotated annually in alphabetical order among the high schools of the Springfield R-12 System. The first scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior at Central High School. If there is not a qualified applicant, the scholarship would rotate to the next school the following year.

- B. Application procedure will require three letters of recommendation, including a letter from a Family and Consumer Sciences teacher and the high school principal or counselor.
- C. The selection committee shall include a Family and Consumer Sciences teacher from the high school at which the scholarship is being awarded or the committee will confer with a teacher before selecting the recipient.
- D. After receiving proof of enrollment at the college or university, the Foundation shall send a check payable to the institution. The scholarship will not be renewable.
