Guidelines

1. Name: Remember Pepperdine! Scholarship
2. Established: May 2002
3. Purpose: To acknowledge the sincere efforts of a former Pepperdine Elementary student who is graduating from a Springfield Public High School and offer financial assistance to further that student's education.
4. Criteria:
 - a. Applicant must be a graduating senior from a Springfield Public High School.
 - b. Applicant must have attended Pepperdine Elementary School in May 2002.
 - c. Applicant must be deemed by the faculty of the high school they are currently attending as making a sincere effort to continue his/her education.
 - d. Applicant must be pursuing education at a college, university, technical or trade school.
5. Amount: The amount of the scholarship will be at least \$100 per year in 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, and 2013. In 2014, if remaining funds exceed \$100, the selection committee may make one or multiple awards in order to deplete the fund.

6. Procedure:
- a. Scholarship will be awarded annually to a graduating senior based upon letters of recommendation from one teacher and one principal or counselor.
 - b. The selection committee shall include one high school counselor, one high school teacher and a staff or board member of the Foundation for Springfield Public Schools.
 - c. Upon notification from the selection committee and confirmation from the educational institution, the Foundation for Springfield Public Schools shall send a check payable to the educational institution of choice.
 - d. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based on the same protocol.
