



## **ERNIE PRATT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

### ***Guidelines***

- 1. Name:** Ernie Pratt Memorial Scholarship
- 2. Established:** This scholarship was established in memory of Mr. Ernie Pratt who was the instrumental music teacher at Kickapoo High School from 1971 until his retirement in 1984. During that time he also directed the Springfield Youth Symphony. SEA transferred scholarship to the FFSPS in 2008.
- 3. Amount:** The amount of the scholarship will vary each year according to interest earned on the corpus of the fund. The award amount should not exceed the available interest earned unless the difference would be supplemented from other sources.
- 4. Purpose:** To assist a Kickapoo High School student.
- 5. Criteria:**
  - A. This scholarship will be awarded annually to a senior of Kickapoo High School who has been active in instrumental music at KHS or one who has been active in the Springfield Youth Symphony- preferably a student who plans to major in music education.
  - B. Application must rank in the upper one-fourth of the graduating class, demonstrate good citizenship, leadership, dependability, initiative, perseverance and seriousness of purpose.
  - C. Applicant must have demonstrated financial need and limited resources to continue with their education.
- 6. Procedure:**
  - A. Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior of Kickapoo High School.
  - B. The Kickapoo High School scholarship selection committee will make the recipient recommendation. If there are no applicants who meet the restrictions, this scholarship shall be awarded to a deserving student determined by the selection committee.
  - C. After receiving proof of enrollment, the Foundation shall send a check payable to that institution.
  - D. The scholarship will not be renewable.
