8. The Parkview Scholarship Committee, the Student Council sponsor, the assistant principal in charge of school activities, and a performing group sponsor will select the recipient of the award.
9. The name of the recipient will be placed on a plaque each year and the plaque will be kept on display at Parkview High School.

4. Integrity, dependability, initiative, perseverance, and seriousness of purpose
5. Need for financial assistance to continue education.
