



## ROBERT ROTENBERRY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

### *Guidelines*

- 1. Name:** Robert Rotenberry Memorial Scholarship
- 2. Established:** Robert died in an auto accident the year following his graduation from Parkview High School in 1989. This scholarship was established by family and friends in 1990. SEA transferred to FFSPS in 2008.
- 3. Amount:** The amount of the scholarship will vary each year according to interest earned on the corpus of the fund. The award amount should not exceed the available interest earned unless the difference would be supplemented from other sources.
- 4. Purpose:** To assist a Parkview High School senior, who has been a member in good standing on the basketball and/or track varsity level (preferably both) during the junior and senior years who pursue a higher education.
- 5. Criteria:**
  - A. This scholarship will be awarded annually to a Parkview senior who shows evidence of furthering his/her education in the name of Robert Rotenberry in memory of him as a student from Parkview High School.
  - B. Application must rank in the upper one-half of the graduating class, demonstrate good citizenship, leadership, dependability, initiative, perseverance and seriousness of purpose.
  - C. Applicant must have demonstrated financial need and limited resources to continue with their education.
- 6. Procedure:**
  - A. Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior.
  - B. The High School scholarship selection committee (which should include the boys basketball and boys track coach) will make their recipient recommendation.
  - C. After receiving proof of enrollment, the Foundation shall send a check payable to that institution.
  - D. The scholarship will not be renewable. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based on the same protocol.
