



Kickapoo High School Coach Sue Schuble Scholarship *Guidelines*

- 1. Name:** Kickapoo High School Coach Sue Schuble Scholarship
- 2. Established:** SEA transferred scholarship to the FSPS in 2008.
- 3. Amount:** The amount of the scholarship will vary each year according to interest earned on the corpus of the fund. The award amount should not exceed the available interest earned unless the difference would be supplemented from other sources.
- 4. Purpose:** To assist a female Kickapoo High School senior , who has been a member in good standing on the varsity volleyball and/or basketball team.
- 5. Criteria:**
 - A. This scholarship will be awarded annually to a graduating female senior from Kickapoo High School who has been a member of good standing on the varsity volleyball or basketball team. In the event that no one is eligible with those requirements, the recipient may be a female KHS student who is interested in pursuing a degree in education.
 - B. Application must rank in the upper one-fourth of the graduating class, demonstrate good citizenship, leadership, dependability, initiative, perseverance and seriousness of purpose.
 - C. Applicant must have demonstrated financial need and limited resources to continue with their education.
 - D. Applicant must attach a brief essay that describes her college career plans and how participation in athletics has impacted her life.**
 - E. A brief letter of reference from each of the following: teacher, personal acquaintance (non-relative), and a coach.**
- 6. Procedure:**
 - A. Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior.
 - B. The High School scholarship selection committee will make their recipient recommendation.
 - C. After receiving proof of enrollment, the Foundation shall send a check payable to that institution.
 - D. The scholarship will not be renewable. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based on the same protocol.
