

CLASS OF 1921 G. PEARSON WARD III SCHOLARSHIP Guidelines

1. Name: Class of 1921 G. Pearson Ward III Scholarship

2. Established: By the Senior High School Class of 1921 and named in honor of

Classmate G. Pearson Ward. Mr. Ward was founder & long time

manager of KTTS Radio and KTTS-TV (Channel 10).

3. Amount: The amount of the scholarship will vary each year according to

interest earned on the corpus of the fund. The award amount should not exceed the available interest earned unless the difference would be

supplemented from other sources.

4. Purpose: To assist students in continuing their education at a college,

university, technical, trade or vocational school.

5. Criteria:

A. Applicant must be a graduating student from Central High School in the Springfield R-12 Public School system.

B. Application must rank in the upper one-fourth of the graduating class, demonstrate good citizenship, leadership, dependability,

initiative, perseverance and seriousness of purpose.

C. Applicant must have demonstrated financial need and limited

resources to continue with their education.

6. Procedure:

A. Scholarship will be awarded annually to a graduating senior from Central High School who plans to enter the field of communications (radio, television, journalism, drama, electronics or

other communicative art form.

B. The Central High scholarship selection committee will make their recipient recommendation to the Foundation for

Springfield Public Schools.

C. After receiving proof of enrollment, the Foundation shall send

a check payable to that institution.

D. The scholarship will not be renewable. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based

on the same protocol.
