Jennifer Elizabeth Whiteaker Memorial Scholarship for Glendale High School *Guidelines*

- 1. Name:** Jennifer Elizabeth Whiteaker Memorial Scholarship
- 2. Established:** April 1998
- 3. Amount:** The amount will vary each year according to interest earned on the corpus of the fund. The award amount should not exceed 90 percent of available interest earnings unless the difference is supplemented from other sources.
- 4. Purpose:**
 - A. To assist and motivate outstanding young women to continue their education at a college or university, preferably (but not required) to the University of Missouri-Columbia.
 - B. To encourage female graduating seniors to pursue academic studies with a preference to, but not limited to, education or foreign language.
- 5. Criteria:**
 - A. Applicant must be a graduating senior from Glendale High School in the R-12 Public School system.
 - B. Applicant is preferred to have, but not required, a strong interest in pursuing studies in teacher education or a foreign language.
 - C. Applicant must have a financial need relative to educational expenses.
- 6. Procedure:**
 - A. Scholarship will be awarded annually to a graduating senior at Glendale High School.
 - B. Application procedure will require three letters of recommendation including a letter from one of the student's high school teachers and principal or counselor.
 - C. The selection committee should include at least one teacher from Glendale High School. The family suggested Jim Whytlaw be included.
 - D. After receiving proof of enrollment of the selected recipient at an accredited college or university, the Foundation shall send a check payable to that institution.

- E. The scholarship will not be renewable. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based on the same protocol.
