E. Wade and Flo Williams Memorial Scholarship

Guidelines

1. Name: E. Wade and Flo Williams Memorial Scholarship
2. Established: May 1998
3. Amount: The amount will vary each year according to the corpus of the fund and shall not exceed the available interest earnings. The annual award amount shall be in compliance with the Springfield Public Schools Foundation policy on endowed scholarship account pay-out.
4. Purpose: To assist and motivate students with academic promise to continue their education.
5. Criteria:
 - a. Applicant must be a graduating senior of Central High School and/or Hillcrest High School.
 - b. Applicant must have a strong desire to complete an educational program.
6. Procedure:
 - a. Scholarship will be awarded annually to a graduating senior at Central High School and/or Hillcrest High School.
 - b. Application procedure requires at least one letter of recommendation from one of the student's high school principal or counselor.
 - c. After receiving proof of enrollment of the selected recipient at an acceptable institution of learning, the Foundation shall send a check payable to that institution.
 - d. The scholarship will not be renewable. If there is no suitable applicant for a particular academic year, the scholarship will not be awarded that year only and will be awarded the following year based on the same protocol.
